SMSA school offers both Preschool and Pre-K Programs. Having separate programs allows the teachers at SMSA to focus on individual skills that are specific to each age group and to help better prepare the four year olds for Kindergarten.

Our Preschool and Pre-K Programs are designed to accommodate parents with varied schedules. SMSA offers half or full day classes. You can choose to send your child 2, 3, or 5 days each week. The morning session begins at 8:00 am and ends at 11:00 am. The extended day begins at 8:00 am and ends at 3:00 pm.

Before and after school care is available.

Children staying all day may bring a lunch or purchase one through SMSA's homemade hot lunch program.

The SMSA Preschool and Pre-K are hands-on as well as academic programs. They are fun and exciting beginnings to formal education.

Small class sizes allow our teachers to give your child individual attention.

The Preschool Program is for those children who will turn three by September 1st.

Our Preschool Program is designed to provide your child with a strong foundation in the fundamentals that are essential to learning.

We believe and are committed to educating the whole child in the areas of intellectual, emotional, social, spiritual and physical growth.

We accomplish this through daily lessons in music, gross motor activities, religion, small and large group activities, story time, circle time.

 9:30-9:45 Circle time
 9:45-10:00 Story time
 10:00-10:45 Centers
 10:45-11:00 Prepare for lunch, story time
 AM students depart at 11:00
 11:00-12:00 Lunch and recess
 12:00-12:15 Potty break, prepare for rest time
 12:15-2:15 Rest time
 2:15-2:30 Potty break, clean up cots/blankets
 2:30-2:50 Free play
 2:50-3:00 Prepare for home, story time
 PM students depart
